Description

Front: Kopf einer Frau mit langem ungebundenem Haar (Gallia?) nach r., dahinter eine Kriegstrompete (Carnyx).

Rear: Diana in Frontalansicht, in der l. Hand ein Speer, mit der r. Hand das Geweih eines nach r. springenden Hirsches haltend.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
