## Description

Front: Kopf des Traianus mit Lorbeerkranz nach r.

Rear: Aeternitas in Vorderansicht nach l., in der r. Hand eine Büste des Sol, in der l. Hand eine Büste der Luna, den Gewandsaum über den Hinterkopf hochgezogen (capite velato).

Chop mark: A mark of undefined form made normally with a chisel-like tool, for example to test the purity of the core of a coin. It can also be the result of damage caused when the object was found.
